- Be willing and able to self promote your own show

What you get

Beyond the chance to perform in our beautiful damp cellar, FDWL is the place to try out new ideas and much of the work has gone on to perform their shows across the country. You will receive marketing support, technical help for your get-in and 50% of box office takings. Plus an artist ticket pass to see any shows in FDWL for £1.

Previous FDWL Festivals have seen excellent shows go on to achieve success. In Bed With My Brother took Edinburgh by storm in 2016 with their show *We Are Ian* and are now working on their 2nd show and embarking on an Australian tour, Above Bounds have just completed a rural tour with their show *The Ugly Duckling* and Freya Bardell will be doing her show *Twenty Something* in our current season.
